## Bargaining with MSU

The current collective bargaining agreement that GEU has with MSU expires on May 15th, 2023. <u>That means</u> that this year is a bargaining year, where we research, propose, and negotiate a new contract with MSU. Because of our contract, graduate employees at MSU continued to receive wage increases each year throughout the pandemic while the university made cuts to the wages and retirement contributions of non-unionized employees. Join the union, recruit your friends, and stand in solidarity with your fellow graduate employees so we can defend our rights to a fair and living wage and safe working conditions!
