Many graduate assistants were not paid in September due to an issue in the MSU HR department who claims that the delay in pay occurred because these students' appointments were processed late. However, as graduate students we are not responsible for submitting our appointments and we have no power in the process. Why must we suffer the consequences of this negligence!? For first year students who may have little or no savings missing a paycheck may be catastrophic, yet the administration has been slow to react.

The GEU swiftly filed a grievance on behalf of several departments and met with affected members. So far, we have resolved the issue for the Chemistry department and hope more departments will follow.

We have the chance to rectify this kind of negligence in the 2023 - 2027 contract by demanding *all late payments be refunded with interest*. The administration will oppose us on this issue and we must be united to achieve this. The GEU needs engaged members during this crucial bargaining cycle. MSU only works because we do!!


